1. Be in jubilant mood 歡呼的情緒
2. Be in high spirit 情緒高漲
3. ...with a big grin 滿面笑容
4. Be on cloud nine 極快樂

1. Be in a fury 在狂怒中
2. Fly into a rage 勃然大怒
3. Be out of temper 情緒失控

# SUPER SENTENCE PATTERNS

## (FOR DESCRIPTIVE WRITING)

**1. So + Adj. + is/ are/ was/ were + S. + that + (SVO) 多麼...以致**

E.g. So nervous was I that I felt as if my heart had stopped.

---

**2. Never + Auxiliary Verb + SVO. 從沒有...**

E.g. Never had I experienced such a feeling.

# SUPER SENTENCE PATTERNS

## (FOR DESCRIPTIVE WRITING)

**3. Seldom/ Rarely/ Scarcely + Auxiliary Verb + SVO. 很少**

E.g. Prior to this time's performance, seldom did he disappoint the audience.

**4. It was not until + Noun + that + SVO. 直至... 才**

E.g. It was not until that moment that I realized health is the most important thing in life.

# SUPER SENTENCE PATTERNS

## (FOR DESCRIPTIVE WRITING)

**5. It occurs to / strikes/ dawns on + sb. that + SVO 突然瞭解**

E.g. It never occurred to me that my friend spoke ill behind my back.

E.g. When I was playing the piano last night, it crossed my mind that piano is my lifelong passion.

E.g. It struck me that friendship is something you should treasure.
