

1. Encouraging average candidates so with weak candidates)

2. Interruption



E.g. Well, May I add something here?/
Would you mind if I say something here?

(No need to wait for any response)
+
disagree/ change topic

3. Dealing with troublesome candidates

E.g.

1. It's okay if you insist. Then may I ask if we can move on and talk about a different topic for now?

2. It seems that we can't reach an agreement yet, shall we put it aside now and talk about other things?

4. Going off topic

- Yeah I see what you mean. (It's true that...) but we're supposed to talk about XXX according to the question. So let's get back to the topic for the time being.

5. Being accused of going off the topic

6. Going back to the previous point

- **That's a great idea and there's something that I'd like to share to complement your idea – I believe it will help facilitate the discussion.**

8. Being unfamiliar with specific...
